

CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING **100% preventable**.

Know it.



Carbon monoxide is an odorless, colorless and tasteless gas.



You **WILL NOT** be able to sense a carbon monoxide leak.



Carbon monoxide is produced when any source of fuel is burned.*

*Examples include: grills, furnaces, water heaters, automobiles, boats, stoves, generators, gas ranges, fire places, portable heaters and chainsaws.

Avoid it.



Keep portable generators outdoors and away from windows and doors.



Avoid idling cars inside closed garages.



Get furnaces and other **fuel-burning appliances serviced regularly.**



Don't use camp stoves, grills or gasburning tools like chainsaws indoors.

Prevent it.



Install a carbon monoxide detector near any area used for sleeping.



Use a carbon monoxide detector while **boating**, **camping and ice fishing**.
